However, we are always open to other innovative, creative project ideas. A project is a carefully designed initiative that involves innovative, effective legal advocacy on behalf of individuals, groups or issues that are not adequately represented by some aspect of the legal system. Projects provide Fellows with the opportunity to exercise leadership on a distinct project. Individuals and host organizations will work together to generate project proposals.

You must be a third year law student, a recent law school graduate who has not held a full-time, permanent public interest attorney position, or an experienced private attorney looking to begin a public interest career. Your law school must be an Equal Justice Works member law school at the time you apply. The EJW Fellowship applications opened on June 20, 2018 and are due on September 21, 2018.
